

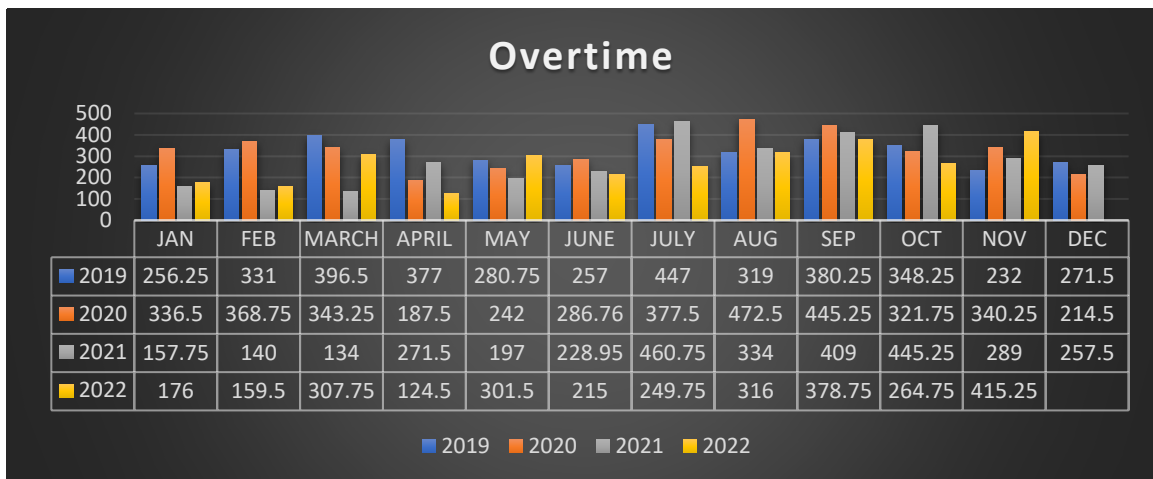

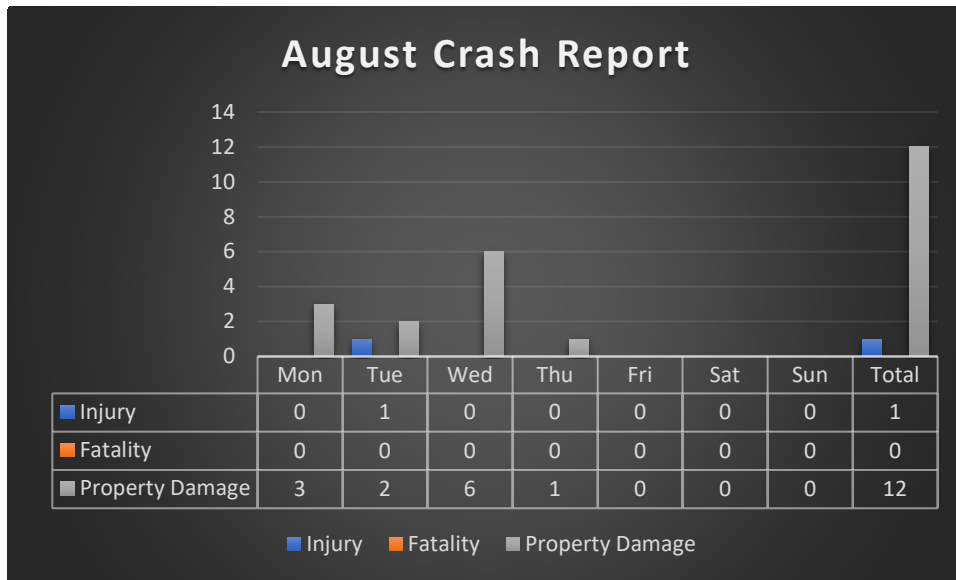

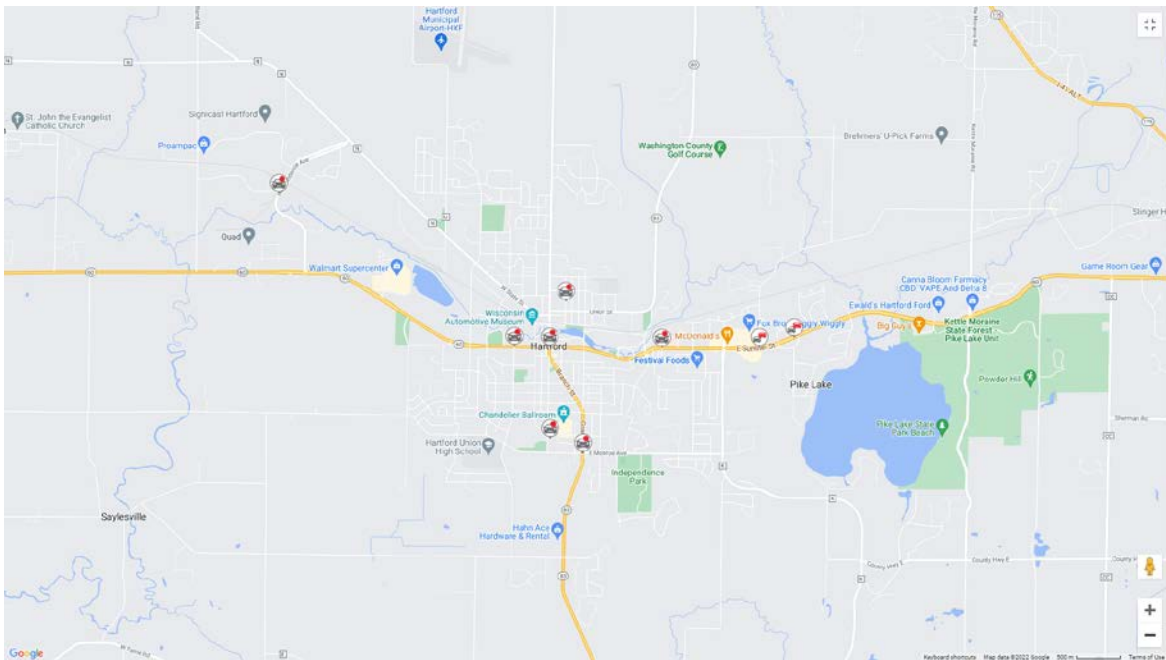

The month of August saw a slight decrease in overtime from the previous years.



During the month of August, officers investigated four less vehicular crash incidents than the previous month. One crash was personal injury related, and twelve resulted in property damage. ### ***2.) USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS***

During the month of August, there was a use of force incident reported. Officers were called to a residence for a report of a domestic disturbance.
